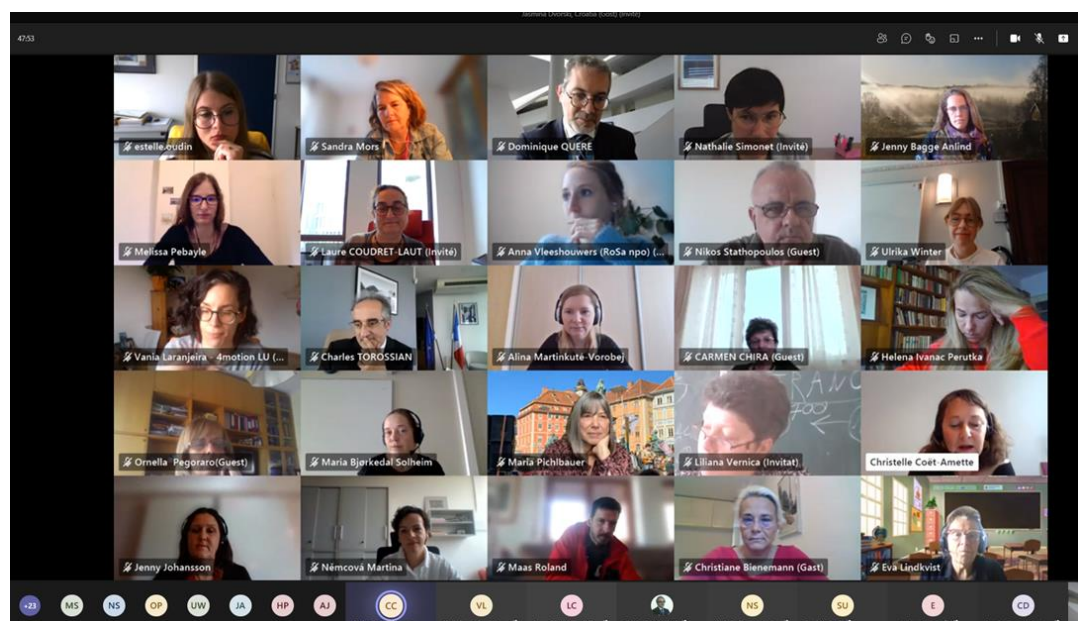

The ERASMUS+ Agency France and the IH2EF had a shared desire, starting in 2020, to propose a study visit to France on the subject of tackling gender stereotypes in education and training.

The COVID crisis forced a postponement to 2021. It also imposed to have a distance learning & networking activity.

The Agency and the Institute had to face several challenges: offering quality speeches in English, managing to devise activities that foster exchanges and interactions, laying the groundwork for international mobility & cooperation projects, ensuring a good level of commitment, despite the difficulty that video-conferencing-arrangements may be difficult



Between 25 and 27 June, nearly 30 participants from 17 European Union countries logged in to take part in the workshops and listen to lectures given by our speakers.

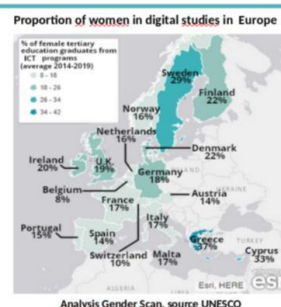
The role of girls in the field of digital technologies is problematic in many European countries. It was a question of becoming aware of the work to be done and the many opportunities in the years to come.
